

Patsy Mink Memorial Scholarship

Patsy Mink was the first Woman of Color elected to the U.S. House of Representatives and the first Asian-American woman to serve in Congress. Her significant contributions include advocacy for gender and racial equality, affordable childcare, and bilingual education. A strong supporter of Title IX, this law was renamed in her honor posthumously: Patsy T. Mink Equal Opportunity in Education Act.

Recipients will receive one full scholarship for a *Grantsmanship Training Program - Online* course and textbook (value \$1,255). Recipients will have 6 months from the date of the award to register and complete the class on the dates of their choice. Applicants must be working with a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and submit:

- This application
- Documentation of 501(c)(3) status (Determination Letter from the IRS or current 990)
- Organizational budget showing revenue of \$1,000,000 or less. Budget includes revenue & expenses.

Deadline to apply for the 2024-2025 cycle is Friday, November 1, 2024.
